**2008 WARRANT FOR THE ANNUAL MEETING OF  
THE GUNSTOCK ACRES VILLAGE WATER DISTRICT**

**T**o the inhabitants of the Gunstock Acres Village Water District in the Town of Gilford qualified to vote at said district affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet in the Gilford Town Hall in said Town of Gilford on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of March 2008 at 9:00am to act upon the subjects hereinafter set forth in the following Warrant Articles; subjects dealing with district officers, the budget, and other necessary matters.

**ARTICLE 1:**

- A. Nominate candidates for **commissioner** for a three (3) year term and, upon the close of nominations for commissioner, vote to elect a commissioner.
- B. Nominate candidates for **moderator** for a one (1) year term and, upon the close of nominations for moderator, vote to elect a moderator.
- C. Nominate candidates for **clerk** for a one (1) year term and upon the close of nominations for clerk, vote to elect a clerk.
- D. Nominate candidates for **treasurer** for a one (1) year term and, upon close of nominations, vote for a treasurer

Note: All votes will be by secret ballot and will take place immediately upon the close of nominations.

**Article 2:**

To see if the GAVWD will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$198,380 to fund the General Operations of the GAVWD. This amount excludes all other warrant articles.

*The Commissioners and the Budget Committee recommend this appropriation.  
Majority vote required.*

**Article 3:**

To see if the GAVWD will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$10,000 to be added to a Capitol Reserve pursuant to RSA 31:19a, (with the Board of Water Commissioners as agent) authorized to expend the funds in the trust in accordance with the purposes set forth in this article.) The purpose of said Capital Reserve is to repair major equipment as it deteriorates under routine usage. Should the need not arise, the purpose would be to have this money available when the equipment needs to be replaced or substituted with more current and/or recommended equipment or methods.

*The Commissioners and the Budget Committee recommend this appropriation.  
Majority vote required.*

**Article 4:**

To see if the GAVWD will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$80,000 to be added to an expendable trust fund pursuant to RSA 31:19a, known as the tank/major equipment fund with the Board of Water Commissioners as agent authorized to expend the funds in the trust in accordance with the purposes set forth in this article. The purpose of said fund is to repair major equipment as it deteriorates under routine usage. Should the need not arise, the purpose would be to have this money available when the equipment needs to be replaced or substituted with more current and/or recommended equipment or methods.

*The Commissioners and the Budget Committee recommend this appropriation.  
Majority vote required*


**Article 5:**

To see if the GAVWD will vote to authorize the Commissioners to borrow in anticipation of taxes and/or other revenue in accordance with the Municipal Finance Act RSA 33:7.


**Article 6:**

To see if the GAVWD will vote to indemnify and save harmless any person employed by it and any member or officer of its governing board, administrative staff or agencies, including, but not limited to the commissioners, from personal loss and expense including reasonable legal fees and costs, if any, arising out of any claim, demand, suit, or judgment by reason of negligence or other act resulting in accidental injury to a person or accidental damage to or destruction of property, if the indemnified person at the time of the accident resulting in the injury, damage, or destruction was acting in the scope of his employment or office. *This article provides the statutory protections authorized by RSA 31:105.*




