EARTHEN DEBRIS/ROCKS:

- clean fill allowed

FLUORESCENT BULBS:

- No broken bulbs

COMPOSTABLE YARD WASTE:

- Leaves
- Grass clippings

METALS:

- Large or small items without Freon
- **Please purchase a coupon for items w/Freon from DPW****

STUMPS / CHUNK WOOD:

- Requires pre-payment of loads according to a fee schedule at Public Works office.

THERMOSTAT COLLECTIONS:

- Any wall-mounted thermostats only with glass tube mercury switches.
(No broken tubes)

WOOD CHIPS:

- Chips must be kept separate from Compostable items

ASPHALT (FREE) / CEMENT (SEE BELOW)

- Homeowners = 1 P/U Load per month free
- Contractors = "6 Wheel loads" and up require pre-payment of loads according to a fee schedule at Public Works office.

RECHARGABLE BATTERIES:

- Cellular and Cordless phones
- Rechargeable batteries as found in cordless power tools, motors, laptop computers, camcorders, digital cameras, and remote control toys. (Battery chemistries: Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd), Nickel Metal Hydride (Ni-MH), Lithium Ion (Li-ion) and Small Sealed Lead* (Pb).

GOODIE'S EXCHANGE: (PLEASE ONLY DROP OFF THINGS SOMEONE ELSE MIGHT WANT!!)

- This building can accept small reusable items, CLEAN USABLE CLOTHES.
If you can carry it, we probably want it.

COOKING OIL (LIQUID STATE) / WASTE MOTOR OIL: (Not contaminated with water, antifreeze or other materials)

- May be brought to either the Gilford Recycling Center, or Dept. of Public Works at 55 Cherry Valley Road, Gilford.
