Date of Release: Monday, February 9, 2015

Date of Incident: Saturday, February 7, 2015

Location: 118 Weirs Road, Gilford, NH 03249

Incident: On Saturday, February 7, 2015, at approximately 1745 hours, the Gilford Police Department responded to an employee reported fight in progress between patrons at the Misty Harbor Resort. The initial report indicated a possible firearm may be involved somehow. Upon officers arriving, contact was made with a group of individuals who confirmed a fight had ensued over a parking space. It was during the altercation between patrons that an alleged assault had taken place. Officers learned through their investigation that Michael E. DELISLE, 68, of 5 Pasture Road, North Swanzey, NH, had allegedly commented during an argument with another individual that he was going to "get his .357 and put a bullet in your head now."

Officers later swore to and obtained a search warrant for a vehicle believed to contain the firearm in question. Upon executing the search warrant, a .357 Magnum revolver was, in fact, located and seized as evidence. Subsequently, Michael E. DELISLE was arrested and charged with *Criminal Threatening*, a Class A misdemeanor.

Also arrested was Blaine DELISLE, 70, of 322 Coddington Hollow Road, Johnson, VT, who was charged with *Simple Assault*, a Class A misdemeanor.

At this time, it is unclear what the relationship is between the two subjects arrested. Both were transported to the Gilford Police Department, processed, and later released on \$1,000.00 each personal recognizance bail. Both have an arraignment date of Thursday, March 19, 2015, at the 4th Circuit - District Division - Laconia Court.

The investigation is ongoing, and additional arrests and criminal charges are being considered.
