The Gilford Board of Selectmen will hold two public hearings as follows:

APPROPRIATION OF UNANTICIPATED FUNDS

Acceptance and authorization to spend a \$20,000 donation from the Jensen Benevolence Fund to the Gilford Fire Department pursuant to the provisions of RSA 31:95-b, as authorized by a vote on Article 12 of the 1994 Town Meeting. If approved, these funds will be used for kitchen renovations at the Fire Station.

AMENDMENTS TO SOLID WASTE CENTER FEE SCHEDULE

Implementation of a new fee of \$0.09 per pound for construction and demolition debris, \$0.02 per pound for large logs, and \$0.01 per pound for concrete with rebar, in place of the current size estimate fees, (due to the new scale being used), along with new fees (\$1 & \$5) for propane tanks to cover the cost of disposal. The authority of the Selectmen to adopt fees is granted pursuant to the provisions of RSA 41:9-a, as further authorized by a vote on Article 30 of the 2018 Town Meeting and Article 15 of the 1990 Town Meeting. If approved, these new fees will take effect immediately.

Any interested person may attend this public hearing and present testimony related thereto. Written remarks will be accepted for input up until 5pm on the day of the hearings.

Subject: Donation

Gilford Fire-Rescue requests permission to accept a donation of \$20,000 to be used to remodel the kitchen at the fire station.

Approximately 2 months ago, I was approached by Mr David Jensen who stated that in the near future, he would see that we received a donation from his late Aunt's estate. Dave is a retired Laconia firefighter and wanted to be sure the money was used for something that the Town would not typically fund or be asked to fund. He gave us an idea of the amount and told us to think about it. All of the full-time members were asked to brainstorm a few ideas; and, the kitchen remodel rose to the top of the list.

We have received one quote, to date, along with a plan. The plan will increase storage space, replace cabinets, counter tops and the sink; and, install an island. A larger range and refrigerator are planned.

To accomplish the improvements and to add space, the bathroom immediately adjacent to the existing kitchen will be removed.

We would appreciate your support of this much-needed project by allowing us to accept the donation and use the funds for the fire station kitchen remodel.
