RE: Acceptance of NH Office of Highway Safety Grant Funds

As in years past, GPD applied for FY2022 NH Office of Highway Safety (NHoHS) grant funds for saturation patrol purposes. I recently received notification from the NHoHS that GPD has been awarded an overall total grant amount of \$18,475.00, which includes the following expenditure breakdowns:
