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GILFORD BOARD OF SELECTMEN NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

Wednesday, March 27, 2024 6:00pm Gilford Town Hall – First Floor Conference Room

The Gilford Board of Selectmen will hold a public hearing on proposed amendments to the Solid Waste Center Fee Schedule, followed by a public hearing on proposed amendments to the Solid Waste Center Regulations, pursuant to the authority granted under RSA 41:9-a (as further authorized under Article 15 of the 1990 Town Meeting) and RSA 149-M:17 (as further authorized under Article 30 of the 2018 Annual Town Meeting). The proposed amendments are scheduled to take effect as of April 1, 2024.

AMENDMENTS TO SOLID WASTE CENTER FEE SCHEDULE

Construction & demolition debris from nine cents per pound to ten cents per pound; mattresses from \$10 each to \$15; small tires from \$3 each to \$4; large tires from \$5 each to \$5.50; small electronics from \$5 each to \$6; large electronics from \$10 each to \$12; appliances with freon from \$10 each to \$12; concrete with rebar from two cents per pound to three cents per pound; stumps from \$10 each to three cents per pound; logs from two cents per pound to three cents per pound; and commercial sale of loam (processed mulch) from \$18 per cubic yard to \$20 per cubic yard.

AMENDMENTS TO SOLID WASTE CENTER REGULATIONS

Commercial disposal of brush, stumps, logs, and concrete with rebar would be prohibited. All other commercial disposal of yard waste products would be subject to space availability and inventory controls. The Town will also provide written authorization for Gilford commercial haulers and businesses to bring their waste products to the Laconia Transfer Station.

Subject: Gilford Solid Waste Updated Fee Schedule

The Board of Selectmen last approved the Gilford Solid Waste Center (GSWC) Fee Schedule in December 2021. At the end of 2022, it did not appear that fee increases were needed at the time. After 2023 year-end data we are **recommending several changes** to the GSWC Fee Schedule:

All increases are based on actual costs to process, recycle or dispose of the item with specific vendors. I am attaching the year end summary and have further backup if needed on each item should you wish to see it. I am also **recommending that the Town NOT accept commercial chunk wood, logs and stumps** as this has a significant cost and currently represents approximately 50% of the material we have on site. There is no benefit to taxpayers for the GSWC to accept commercial wood. We are still accepting commercial asphalt, concrete w/o rebar, leaves, grass and chips as these materials can be reused on town projects (providing cost-offsetting) or sold for revenue. It is also recommended that we continue to NOT accept commercial brush so that we can properly manage brush pile burning.

SOLID WASTE CENTER REGULATIONS AMENDMENTS (CHAPTER 10)

KNOW ALL PERSONS BY THESE PRESENTS, the Gilford Board of Selectmen hereby ordains to amend the Solid Waste Center Regulations as follows:

10.5.2 RESIDENTIAL USE ONLY

The use of the Gilford Solid Waste Center for disposal of household trash, recyclables, construction & demolition debris, bulky wastes, burning.stumps.logs, and electronics shall be limited to residential purposes only. Commercial haulers, commercial businesses, contractors and anyone who is being paid to transport someone else's trash shall be required to bring their waste products to the Laconia Transfer Station where they shall be subject to the rules and fees of the City of Laconia, except where specifically noted otherwise in these regulations. <a href="mailto:The Town shall provide authorization letters upon request for commercial haulers and contractors to transport waste products from Gilford to the Laconia Transfer Station upon verification the items are coming from a Gilford property. The Town shall not subsidize or pay any costs associated with the disposal of any waste products delivered to the Laconia Transfer Station on behalf of Gilford residents and taxpayers.

10.5.7 YARD WASTE

- (a) The Town will accept, to the extent that space is available, commercial and residential yard waste products consisting of clean wooden boards (no nails, screws, paint or stain present), stumps, logs (no wider than 6 inches in diameter or 6 feet long), brush, leaves, mulch, concrete, asphalt, bricks, pavers, and other similar products. Commercial haulers and contractors situated in the Town of Gilford will be allowed to deliver leaves, mulch, asphalt, concrete without rebar, bricks and pavers from Gilford properties upon proof of origin, subject to space availability.
- 10.6.3 The Town authorizes the Director of Public Works and/or the Solid Waste Superintendent to temporarily suspend or amend these rules at any time for safety reasons, *inventory controls*, adjustments in recycling market conditions, or in order to comply with ever-changing state and federal

regulations that may be applicable to the disposal of waste products as otherwise noted in these regulations.
