APPLICATIONS:

1. Wetlands Permit by Notification for Doug Surprenant/BLC and Dan Hubley at 132 Scenic Dr. Total Impact of 3,266 sf. Riparian planting on both banks of Reed Brook (between two culverts) for about 100 linear feet. Additional soil and stone (with mortised equipment) to stabilize the areas adjacent to brook & allow larger plantings to take root. Additional care will be given the brook itself, to trap sediment form entering Lake Winnepesaukee. All plantings will be native.
2. Wetlands Permit by Notification for Ronald Campagna Family Trust property at 3012 Lake Shore Rd. Project proposal is to replace an existing docking structure and an ice cluster.
3. Wetlands Permit Application – Standard Dredge and Fill application for Governor's Island Club at 500 Edgewater Drive to improve the revetment system to prevent further erosion of the shoreline.
