

TOWN OF GILFORD  
BUDGET COMMITTEE  
MINUTES  
APRIL 10, 2014

A duly posted, public meeting of the Budget Committee was convened at 7:00pm in the first floor conference room of the Gilford Town Hall.

The following members of the Budget Committee were in attendance: Phyllis Corrigan, Susan Greene, Kevin Leandro, Kevin Roy, Robert Henderson, David Horvath, Richard Grenier, Karen Thurston, Fred Butler, and Allen Voivod.

The assembly recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

S. Greene made a motion to elect P. Corrigan as Chair of the Budget Committee, second by R. Henderson and passed with all in favor (10-0).

S. Greene made a motion to elect K. Leandro as Vice-Chair of the Budget Committee, second by A. Voivod and passed 9-1 with K. Roy opposed.

The Budget Committee discussed alternative methods of filling the vacancy created by the resignation of R. Grenier as an at-large member, who now serves as the Selectmen's Representative.

K. Leandro made a motion to advertise for letters of interest from interested residents to apply for an appointment by the Budget Committee, second by P. Corrigan and passed with all in favor (10-0).

It was the consensus of the Budget Committee to set a deadline of May 8 for applications to be received. It was further agreed that each candidate would be allowed to make an opening statement in public session to be followed by a public question and answer session with the members of the Budget Committee.

It was agreed the Budget Committee would meet on May 15 at 7:00pm to consider candidates for appointment and to establish the meetings times for the Budget Committee going forward.

R. Grenier announced that he recently became a grandfather for the first time.

At 7:30pm A. Voivod made a motion to adjourn, seconded by D. Horvath and passed 9-1 with F. Butler opposed.
