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* Seasonal wages increased by \$100.00

*Merit wages will include Department Heads this year The subtotal of this Section is up \$523.00 (0.3%) mostly due to a health insurance plan change by an employee.

OPERATING (Pg.58)

There are no significant changes to this budget.

Total Operating Expenses are only up \$2415 (5.6%)

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*Meetings/Dues/Professional Development (These three lines increased by \$2535.00 this year. After a three year hiatus, the Director will once again be attending the National RPA Conference in Charlotte, N.C. With the new membership for \$35.00 in USTA, we received grants for 1) equipment for the ten and under age group (\$400-\$600 and 2) a resurfacing of a

*Small Equipment (This line increased by \$750.00 Some of the items requested

had been tabled from last year. Lawn chairs and grills received the most abuse. Sub-committee recommendation: \$40,039.00 - This is \$388.00 less than B.O.S. recommendation pending further discussion of accrued payouts.

SKATING RINK (Pg 62-63)

The Skating Rink Budget has declined \$551.00 from FY2013. Because the insulation has been replaced, it is expected to decrease the cost of heating the facility. The Subcommittee recommends the budget of \$8,115.00 as approved by B.O.S.
