Request for Proposals Concrete Floor Repair

Gilford Fire-Rescue Department is requesting proposals for the repair and re-finish of the fire station floor located at 39 Cherry Valley Rd, Gilford New Hampshire.

Proposals submitted by the vendor must be specific in terms of method of construction and specification of materials used. All vendor/dealer contact information must be included.

Gilford Fire-Rescue will thoroughly review each proposal submitted and reserves the right to select or reject any proposal regardless of price.

General Scope:

This scope of work for this project will include but not limited to:

Repair of concrete spalling and cracks throughout the 6 bay apparatus floor accessible from Cherry Valley Road.

Repair/Replace as necessary the floor drains in the first 3 bays (right to left); which is the slab-over-deck section. These drains and grates are deteriorated and will need to be addressed as part of this renovation.

Epoxy coating or equivalent finish surface will be laid over the existing concrete. This shall be durable enough to withstand the abuse of heavy duty truck traffic. Shall be non-slip, easy to clean, and allow provisions for floor striping.

Required Specifications:

Detailed explanation of surface repairs are required.

In addition, detailed description of materials and products proposed for the floor drain repairs.



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All materials used for the repair shall be of commercial grade, detailed within the proposal.

Detailed description shall be provided for the product used for the final finish.

Detailed warranty information shall be submitted with this proposal.

Paint and Finish:

Final color of the finished product shall be determined by color samples provided by the contractor.
