Request for Proposals 2019 Ford F450 4x4 Super Cab and Chassis

Gilford Fire-Rescue Department is requesting proposals for a Ford F450 to serve as a Forest Fire Fighting vehicle for the Town of Gilford. Performance requirements must meet manufacturer's recommendations and/or Gilford Fire-Rescue requirements.

Proposals submitted by the vendor must be specific in terms of method of construction and specification of materials used. All vendor/dealer contact information must be included.

Gilford Fire-Rescue will thoroughly review each proposal submitted and reserves the right to select or reject any proposal regardless of price.

General Scope:

This truck will function as the primary forest fire fighting vehicle within the Town of Gilford. It will respond to wildland fires in the Town and in to wildland fires in other communities, as a subsequent responder. The truck will be outfitted with an aluminum body and compartments and will carry a forestry skid unit (which includes a pump, water tank, and hose). It is the intent of the buyer to have the rear dual wheel axle changed to a single wheel axel.
