### **Request for Proposals Walkway Repair**

Gilford Fire-Rescue Department is requesting proposals for the replacement of the front walk-way located at 39 Cherry Valley Rd, Gilford New Hampshire.

Proposals submitted by the vendor must be specific in terms of method of construction and specification of materials used. All vendor/dealer contact information must be included.

Gilford Fire-Rescue will thoroughly review each proposal submitted and reserves the right to select or reject any proposal regardless of price.

#### ***General Scope:***

This scope of work for this project will consist of replacement of the existing walk-way at the Fire Station. The removal of the current concrete slabs will be completed by the Town of Gilford DPW prior the project start. The vendor will be required to complete the excavation, preparation, installation of pavers, edging to grass area, loam and hydro-seeding as needing. The project also requires granite curbing at the transition from administration parking lot to the sidewalk. The vendor should submit proposals for all materials.

#### ***Required Specifications:***

Detailed explanation of surface preparation, installation, and materials used is required. Pavers to be used shall resemble the Town Hall building in design and color.



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Cutting of the pavement, industry standard granite curb installation including concrete of both side shall be outlined in the detailed explanation. Asphalt patch shall be the responsibility of the contractor. Parking lot striping will be completed by the Town of Gilford.

Dig safe shall be the responsibility of the contractor.

Detailed warranty information shall be submitted with this proposal.

### ***RFP Advertisement***

- Gilford Fire-Rescue is accepting proposals for replacement of the exterior walkway surrounding the administration wing of the fire station. Proposals will be accepted until **April 15, 2019 at 1600 hrs**, when they will be opened. The best proposal will be chosen on April 16, 2018 at 0815 hrs.
