

John M. & Eileen R. Weeks Conservation Project – Gilford, NH

The Lakes Region Conservation Trust is teaming up with the Gilford Conservation Commission on another Conservation Project in Gilford. Previously, LRCT and Conservation Commission successfully conserved Piper Mountain and the Jail Pasture. This time, LRCT and the Commission are working on conserving the Weeks Property, a 65-acre parcel along Belknap Mountain Road that abuts other conservation land on the village side of Gunstock Mountain.
