Minutes for April 22, 2008 Meeting

1. ATTENDANCE

Members Present: Chairman, John Goodhue; Vice-Chairman, Lee Duncan; Douglas Hill; Larry Routhier; Chuck Coons; Carole Hall and Donald Sibson.

Call meeting to order:

The meeting was called to order by J. Goodhue at 7:00 p.m.

Approval of Agenda:

Motion made by C. Coons, seconded by J. Goodhue, to approve the agenda as presented.

Motion carried with all in favor.

BUSINESS:

1. Belknap Landscape Company, Consultation for Site Plan Review.

Discussion: Commissioners discussed site walk held on April 14, 2008. J. Goodhue spoke about how hard the conditions were due to the snow and mud. They discussed the salt shed as being on the site without a permit. L. Duncan stated concern over the foundation of the salt shed (stacked large concrete blocks) should be sealed to prevent leakage.

Action: Commissioners decided to write a letter to the Planning Board regarding the concerns discussed.

Motion: Made by D. Sibson, seconded by L. Routhier, to recommend the following:

1. The base and sides of the salt shed should be sealed to prevent leakage.
2. The method of the foundation being sealed should be to prevent accidental disturbance by heavy equipment.
3. To make the salt shed permanently waterproof.
4. Proper siltation devices are properly installed before any site work begins.
5. Recommend the Planning Department Office staff monitor Jewett Brook before and after construction.
6. All run off from the site should be directed to the treatment/ detention area at the base of the site near the bypass.

Motion carried with all in favor.

7. ADJOURNMENT

Motion made by D. Sibson, seconded by C. Coons, to adjourn at 7:55 p.m. Motion carried with all in favor.
