1. ATTENDANCE

Call meeting to order:

The meeting was called to order by L. Duncan at 7:00 p.m.

2. APPLICATIONS:

1. **Standard Dredge & Fill Application, William Iannazzi, Gilford Tax Map & Lot #218-001.000**

Applicant proposes to reconfigure and repair existing breakwater and associated dockage, install fender pilings and boat slips, install a 28'x30' seasonal canopy, dredge a boat slip, expand existing perched beach located at 212 Edgewater Drive.

Discussion: The Commissioners noted the breakwater length was non-conforming at 60'. Carole Hall noted the 50' length has been waived in certain cases such as shallow water. L. Duncan observed by moving the breakwater it would cause more environmental impact.

The Commissioners decided to do an on-site inspection.
