

Gilford Conservation Commission
Minutes for October 6, 2009 Meeting

1. ATTENDANCE

Members Present: Chairman-John Goodhue, Vice-Chairman, Lee Duncan; Everett McLaughlin; Chuck Coons; Tom Drouin.

Call meeting to order:

The meeting was called to order by J. Goodhue at 7:05 p.m.

Establish a quorum

J. Goodhue announced a quorum is established.

Approval of Agenda:

Motion made by L. Duncan, seconded by C. Coons, to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried with all in favor.

2. APPLICATIONS:

Standard Dredge and Fill Application-Kathleen Dion Revocable Trust, Gilford Tax Map & Lot #221-023.000, located at 32 Broadview Terrace.

Applicant proposes to repair two existing permitted breakwaters (650 sq ft) by removing small rocks and replacing with larger rocks less prone to movement from ice. All work will maintain size, height and configuration of the existing permitted breakwaters. Also, maintenance dredge of 10 cu yds. silt in an existing boat slip and replace seasonal boatlift for a larger boat.

Discussion: The Commissioners discussed the application and noted the area is prone to high wave activity and ice accumulation.

Motion: Motion made by L. Duncan, seconded by T. Drouin, to recommend approval of the application with the following conditions:

- 1 Normal siltation devices in place prior to construction.

Motion carried with all in favor.

The Commissioners reviewed a Minimum Impact Expedited application submitted by Richard Hickock. Motion made by L. Duncan, seconded by E. McLaughlin to have John Goodhue sign the application. Motion carried with all in favor.

3. PRESENTATIONS-

Nancy Rendall, Bluemoon Environmental, Natural Resource Inventory Update.

Discussion: Nancy Rendall reviewed the maps with the Commissioners and they reviewed the Drinking Water Resources Map, the Base Map, and the Conservation Lands Map.

N. Rendall spoke about co-occurrence maps that can be provided to the Planning Board and they should include locations of steep slopes, water resources, etc as well as a built out of the town.

N. Rendall explained the NRI research will eventually be part of the Master Plan and the Planning Board should be involved in the implementation of the NRI.

N. Rendall will review this revised NRI information for the first meeting in November for another review by the Commissioners.
