Call meeting to order:

Approval of Agenda:

Motion made by T. Drouin, seconded by D. Sibson, to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried with all in favor.

3. APPLICATIONS:

Standard Dredge & Fill Application, Frank Getman, Tax Map & Lot #246-013.000, located at 2 Jolly Island, Gilford, NH 03249.

Applicant proposes to replace existing, permitted 6' x 50' permanent concrete caisson support dock with 6'x50' wood piling permanent supported dock with a 19' "L" including tie odd and ice cluster piles. Also propose to add two seasonal PWC lifts and seasonal boat lift.

The Commissioners discussed their concerns over the existing ledge throughout the area would not allow pilings to be driven in.

They will release the "hold" but want their concern over the ledge included in the comments to the NHDES. They also question the "L" shaped dock with lift facing the prevailing weather.

Action Release hold and include their concerns.

- 1 The impact the existing ledge in the area may have on the proposal.
- 2 The proposed "L" shaped dock with lift is facing prevailing winds instead of parallel along dock.
