

**GILFORD BOARD OF SELECTMEN
Work Session
January 19, 2010
Town Hall**

The Board of Selectmen convened in a special work session on Tuesday, January 19, 2010, at 9:00 a.m., at the Gilford Town Hall, 47 Cherry Valley Road, Gilford, NH. Selectmen present were Gus Benavides, Kevin Hayes and John O'Brien. Also present was Town Administrator Scott Dunn.

Chairman Benavides stated that the purpose of this special work session is to finalize the 2010 Town Warrant.

Discussion began with Article 12, which covers the proposed operating budget for 2010. There were no changes made to Article 12.

Selectman Hayes moved to recommend Article 23, in the amount of \$3,500, for Child and Family Services. Selectman O'Brien seconded. Motion carried by a vote of 2-1. Selectman O'Brien voted no.

Selectman Hayes moved to recommend Article 24, in the amount of \$25,000, for Community Health and Hospice. Selectman O'Brien seconded. Motion carried by a vote of 3-0.

Selectman Hayes moved to recommend Article 25, in the amount of \$8,762, for the Community Action Program (CAP). Selectman O'Brien seconded. Motion carried by a vote of 2-1. Selectman O'Brien voted no.

Selectman Hayes moved to recommend Article 26, in the amount of \$10,916, for Genesis Behavioral Health. Selectman O'Brien seconded. Motion carried by a vote of 2-1. Selectman O'Brien voted no.

The Board concurred that no recommendation would be made on Article 31.

Selectman Hayes moved to approve the 2010 Town Warrant, subject to review by the Department of Revenue. Selectman O'Brien seconded. Motion carried with all in favor.

The work session was adjourned at 9:20 a.m.
