FRADULENT CREDIT CARD TRANSACTIONS LINKED TO NH1 CHILDREN'S AUCTION

The Gilford Police Department has recently been made aware of a potential compromise related to credit card data stored on the NH1 Children's Auction computer server. Gilford Police were contacted and advised that potential fraudulent credit card transactions may have been made after individuals breached a computer server and obtained personal credit card information. As a result, police are working with NH1 Children Auction's staff responsible for maintaining the server in question.

If you, or someone you know, have discovered fraudulent credit card activity believed to be related to the NH1 Children's Auction please consider doing the following.

- * Immediately report any fraudulent credit card transaction(s) to your credit card company.
- * Immediately contact any merchants in order to obtain as much information from them regarding any and all fraudulent transactions.
- * Contact local law enforcement in order to file an official police report.

Gilford Police will take reports of any fraudulent credit card transactions that occurred within their jurisdiction. They are also interested in hearing from others who may be unsuspecting victims to similar criminal activity as common circumstances among cases may assist detectives with their investigations.
