Approval of Trustee Minutes Cott/Leach

New Business:

A. Susan brought a picture of the huge tree in Hoyt Cemetery which is now dropping limbs and breaking headstones. The group decided to try and get pricing on removal for next spring.

B. The Public Works Dept. has completed the ledge pack required for the crane to be able to work in Weeks Cemetery. Judy Cott moved to approve the proposal from Arbor Tech and to send the initial payment to Arbor Tech. Susan Leach seconded.
Motion carried with all in favor.

Old Business:

A. Discussion regarding the state archaeologist, the Belmont Lamprey Cemetery, and Peter Ahern followed. Susan stated that Belmont will pay costs towards having the cemetery dirt that remains brought to Gilford's James Cemetery. Susan will check on the amount of dirt.

B. Dee and Judy noted that they had met with Jessica Felix, from Ossipee, on 8/9/10. She will be submitting a proposal on repair of headstones at Weeks Cemetery. It was also noted that while at Hoyt Cemetery that day, there is still alot of poison ivy. The group decided to check with Hayden, from Belknap Landscaping, to see if 2011 treatment would be necessary.

C. Dee noted she would send a "Thank-You!" to all the companies with cranes and climbers who had taken the time to submit proposals for Weeks Cemetery.

D. Susan noted that there is still many branches and piles of wood in Weeks Cemetery that should be removed before the Crane comes. She asked if Public Works could go in and remove.

The next meetings are scheduled for Gilford Old Home Day, Weeks Cemetery when Arbor Tech confirms a date, and September 15, 2010.
