New Business:

A.    Susan had researched the stone Dee found in Weeks Cemetery on Labor Day. Mrs. Abigail Hoyt, wife of James Hoyt, had the maiden name Whittier. She also contacted the family looking for relatives buried in Gilford Cemeteries by the last name of Clogston. They are actually in the Union Cemetery.

B.    Susan reported she had spoken to Arbor Tech on tree removal at Collins Cemetery. She is waiting on a quote.

C.    Judy mentioned she would not be able to attend the meeting with Scott Dunn regarding the 2011 budget. Susan and Judy suggested recording the conversation so that Judy could review the meeting when she returns.

D.    Dee had been to Weeks Cemetery on 9/11//10. It was discovered that the numbered stones actually marked rows. She and her brother found and set all but three in the proper location. They will return to Weeks on 9/18 to tamper the now standing pillars. The last three will be set ASAP. She also reported finding the Hoyt footstone which had the word "vampire" inscribed on the back side.
