3. New Business

1. Sandy Perry

Applicant is proposing to replace windows and add a door with an entry to the west side of the house located at 28 Potter Hill Rd. TM&L #226-065.000.

Mrs. Perry is proposing to replace (9) windows in the original part of the house with Harvey Classic vinyl windows, 6-light over-clear view, similar in size to existing windows in the house. Top of windows will have white grills between the glass on the top of the windows. One of the replacement windows on the north side of the house will be smaller to allow of height of kitchen counter. Project will be started as soon as possible.
